THE WORD IS THE QUEEN OF THE WORLD (AUT. 449)

On leaving the synagogue, Jesus went to the home of Simon and Andrew with James and John. As Simon's mother-in-law was sick in bed with fever, they immediately told him about her. Jesus went to her and taking her by the hand, raised her up. The fever left her and she began to wait on them. That evening at sundown, people brought to Jesus all the sick and those who had evil spirits: the whole town was pressing around the door. Jesus healed many who had various diseases, and drove out many demons; but he did not let them speak, for they knew who he was. Very early in the morning, before daylight, Jesus went off to a lonely place where he prayed. Simon and the others went out, too, searching for him; and when they found him they said, "Everyone is looking for you." Then Jesus answered, "Let's go to the nearby villages so that I may preach there too; for that is why I came." So Jesus set out to preach in all the synagogues throughout Galilee; he also cast out demons.

But this cure is done when we are open to the compassionate and merciful love of God, and the prompt answer of us, who feel "moved", cured by God: we start serving. Jesus fulfils his mission in that place, he prays to the Father and doesn't stay contemplating what he has done waiting for clapping hands, he leaves to another place so that others can feel also "moved". Claret, as an imitation of Christ, feels a compassionate love to the others. "The love of Christ urges us". He sees the hunger (disease) that the men have for the Word of God, he feels the responsibility of taking the Good News to them, he doesn't become weaker when facing the difficulties, he seeks in the prayer the most urgent and timely things, which makes his preaching to be more effective. "Many times, after a sermon, they came to confess and they left happily afterwards (curation), and they became propagators of the Word IT IS WORD OF GOD (AUT. 450)

Through our claretian charisma, which qualifies all our being, we feel able and intended to do, by the Holy Spirit, an especial service to the Church (Id.5).
